- Lost Profits Nathaniel Curtis was retained as the expert to analyze the
 lost profit calculations of another expert in a breach of contract dispute
 involving a cellular phone service company and their partners. His review
 of the expert report identified significant errors and inconsistencies that
 called into question the reliability and accuracy of the lost profit conclusions
 proposed by the plaintiff.
- Economic Analysis In a dispute concerning a politically charged law
 passed by the city of Phoenix, Mr. Curtis was hired to calculate the economic
 impact of the law when it was appealed to the Arizona Supreme Court. Mr.
 Curtis' analysis demonstrated that the economic impact of rejecting the
 law would cost Arizona businesses tens of millions of dollars annually in
 lost tourism from LGBT friendly visitor revenue. The Arizona Supreme Court
 allowed the law to stand.

Decision-makers in a border county proposed withdrawing from the grant. Nathaniel Curtis was retained to calculate the economic impact of the Stonegarden grant on the county. His analysis demonstrated that the economic benefit of the grant was greater than the cost to administer the grant and created a multiplier effect in the in community that made the grant more valuable to the community than the grant award alone. Decision-makers in the border communities who were presented with Mr. Curtis' analysis elected to continue participating in the grant.
